

## NOTICE OF CANCELLATION - IFRAAZ SHOAIB MOHAMMED

## Summary of the findings of unprofessional conduct of the discipline tribunal

The discipline hearing of Ifraaz Mohammed was held on May 12, 2017 In the written decision of the discipline tribunal dated July 25, 2017, after all of the verbal and written evidence and the submissions placed before it, the tribunal found Ifraaz Mohammed guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:

- Submitted false transcripts purporting to be transcripts for Ifraaz Mohammed from the University of New Brunswick, Carleton University and McMaster University to the CPA Western School of Business to gain entrance to the Professional Education Program.
- Made a false statement and declaration that he had not been subject to an academic rules infraction or misconduct at any post-secondary institution on the application he submitted to the CPA Western School of Business when he had been subject to academic discipline from a Canadian University.

All of which is contrary to the provisions of the *Chartered Professional Accountants Act*, SA 2014, c. C-10.2, or the regulations, by-laws, Rules of Professional Conduct enacted pursuant thereto or standards of practice, constituting unprofessional conduct.

## Orders made as a result of the findings

The Tribunal ordered:

- 1. cancellation of registration as a candidate;
- 2. payment of a fine of \$5,000;
- 3. payment of costs of the investigation, hearing and compliance with the orders, in accordance with bylaw 1601, within 30 days of the issuance of the statement of costs:
- 4. mandatory publication pursuant to section 98 of the CPA Act and bylaws 1550-1557;
- 5. publication of a summary of a decision of unprofessional conduct in the Edmonton Journal and CPA Alberta shall provide a summary of the decision to the CPA educational institutions in the other provinces and territories.
