⁶FNCE 317 and MGST 493 will be accepted for transfer credit if completed prior to Fall 2013 B.Com program. Otherwise, both FNCE 317 and MGST 451 must be taken to receive transfer credit.

⁷Added in August 2017. Starting June 2019, all courses must be taken to receive transfer credit.
