

## Need a mentor? What you need to know

- **Your mentor needs to be registered with CPA Alberta as a mentor**  
If they are not already a registered mentor with CPA Alberta, they need to be a member in good standing and will need to complete a brief orientation in order to be registered.
- **Are you in a pre-approved program? Then your employer will assign a mentor to you!**
- **Are you reporting through experience verification? Here are some tips to help you get a mentor:**
  - Use CPA Canada's resources on effective networking techniques if you're interested in approaching a CPA in your organization or network.
  - Let potential mentors know that there are a number of resources available to support them through the mentoring process and help them cultivate a successful mentor-mentee relationship.
- **Don't know a CPA you'd like to ask to be your mentor? You can then use the helpful CPA Mentor Match Portal—we will pair you with a mentor who works in a similar industry.**
  - Once you have created a profile in PERT, email us to gain access to the program.
