

WHAT AN INCREDIBLE YEAR IT HAS BEEN

In December 2018, Alberta's CPA Education Foundation was contacted by Brian Hesje FCPA, FCA. Brian wanted to make a gift to the Foundation that would increase access for Albertans to the insights and wisdom of the CPA profession. As a former educator, Brian believes in the immense value of education. And, as a visionary leader, he is passionate about supporting the next generation of Alberta leaders.

The CPA Education Foundation worked with Brian to develop an initiative that would achieve his goals. The result? A \$1-million gift from Brian Hesje and the creation of the Foundation's **Hesje CPA Knowledge Centre**. A virtual hub of resources, the Centre is wrapping up its first year of activity. This report touches on the impact Brian's gift has had so far in what has been an auspicious beginning—but just a beginning—for an unprecedented project.

ACTIVITIES OVER THE YEAR

In 2019, a Hesje CPA Knowledge Centre team was established and a three-year action plan was developed for the Centre. The plan transforms Brian's original vision into an ambitious set of initiatives to serve Albertans.



One of the team's first projects was the development of a unique podcast series called *Straight From the CPA's Mouth*. With 17 episodes released in 2019, the series has featured Alberta CPAs sharing their wit and wisdom on topics ranging from leadership to financial literacy.
