



**NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION
RONALD LAWRENCE STODDARD**

Ronald Stoddard appeared before a Discipline Tribunal on April 13, 2004 and was found guilty of unprofessional conduct in having failed to co-operate during 2003 in a practice review as required under Part 4 of the *Regulated Accounting Profession Act*.

The decision of the Discipline Tribunal ordered, in part, that:

In accordance with Section 94 of the Act, **Ronald Stoddard** pay \$4,500 towards the costs of the investigation and hearing and a fine in the amount of \$2,000 within one year from April 27, 2004. If the assessed costs and fine are not paid within the time stipulated, the registration of **Ronald Stoddard** is immediately cancelled.

The costs and fine were payable on April 27, 2005. To date no payment has been received and the full amount remains due to the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Alberta.

This letter is notice to all Chartered Accountants that effective April 28, 2005 the registration of **Ronald Stoddard** as a Chartered Accountant was cancelled.
