

## DISCIPLINE NOTICE MEMBER A

Member A had provided professional accounting services to both shareholders and an operating company. When the shareholders decided to part company, Member A continued to act for one of the shareholders during the sale negotiations. A complaint was received alleging that Member A was in a conflict of interest position.

The complaint was investigated by the Institute and a sanction agreement was accepted when Member A, CA admitted that he was guilty of unprofessional conduct in having:

- 1. provided information for one partner to use in negotiations,
- 2. provided information to one partner regarding the valuation of shares,
- 3. made representations on behalf of the operating company in an e-mail dated August 2, 2006, and
- 4. advocated one partner's position during the negotiations, although he failed to:
- a) determine whether he would be perceived as being in a conflict of interest between the duties owed to both shareholders of the operating company.
- b) develop and advise both shareholders of the conflict management techniques that would be used to manage the conflict, and
- c) obtain the consent of both shareholders to accept the engagement

Member A and the Complaints Inquiry Committee have agreed that the sanctions to be imposed in consequence thereof will be that Member A:

- 1. complete a course in business ethics, as approved by the CIC Chair, by December 31, 2008
- 2. pay a fine of \$10,000 within 30 days of the issuance of the statement of costs
- 3. pay the costs of the investigation and hearing and compliance with the orders within 30 days of the issuance of the statement of costs.

- notice of the Tribunal's findings and orders be provided to any member of the public who directs an enquiry to the Institute about the discipline history of Member A,
