

**DISCIPLINE HEARING
CLINT DUCHARME, CPA, CMA**

A Discipline Tribunal has been convened to conduct a hearing into allegations of unprofessional conduct regarding Clint Ducharme.

The Complaints Inquiry Committee alleges that Clint Ducharme is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:

1. Paid himself or his corporation, XXXXXX Alberta Ltd., \$17,703.11 on April 3, 2019 from VRG bank accounts for his personal benefit, when he knew or ought to have known that he was not entitled to do so; and
2. Personated a subordinate, ID, by taking and using the bank authorization device (fob) issued to them to approve banking transactions that required dual authentication, without the knowledge or consent of the senior management of VRG.

All of which is contrary to the provisions of the *Chartered Professional Accountants Act*, SA 2014, c. C-10.2, or the regulations, by-laws, Rules of Professional Conduct enacted pursuant thereto or standards of practice, constituting unprofessional conduct.
