

## DISCIPLINE HEARING JOCELYN HARRIS, CPA, CA

A Discipline Tribunal has been convened to conduct a hearing into allegations of unprofessional conduct regarding Jocelyn Harris, CPA, CA.

The Complaints Inquiry Committee alleges that Jocelyn Harris, CPA, CA, is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that she, as the former Vice President of Finance of Company A:

- 1. Failed to maintain the good reputation of the profession by providing information to a journalist, which she knew or ought to have known would be used in an article about Company A in Publication A, and in particular, by:
  - a) referencing commercially sensitive information that she received in the course of her employment with Company A; and
  - b) giving her opinions regarding Company A's financial position, which was informed by information that she received through the course of her employment with Company A.

All of which is contrary to the provisions of the *Chartered Professional Accountants Act*, SA 2014, c. C-10.2, c. R-12, or the regulations, bylaws, Rules of Professional Conduct enacted pursuant thereto or standards of practice, constituting unprofessional conduct.
