

Bylaws and Rules Committee

Duties/Responsibilities

The purpose of the committee is to assist the CPA Alberta Board regarding recommendations and exposure drafts relevant to Alberta, including those from the Independence Task Force, Uniform Rules of Professional Conduct, Professional Liability Insurance Committee, and Continuing Professional Development Committee.

As well as recommend to the Board (or its designate) potential changes to the rules of professional conduct or guidance that should be forwarded to the Uniform Rules Standing Committee.

Responsibilities include:

- Review and familiarize themselves with all applicable governing documents, professional standards or other legislation;
- Review recommendations and exposure drafts relevant to CPA Alberta from organizations such as the Independence Task Force, Uniform Rules of Professional Conduct, Professional Liability Insurance Committee, and Continuing Professional Development Committee;
- Prepare for Committee meetings; and
- Assist in preparation of responses on behalf of the CPA Alberta Board in respect of those recommendations and exposure drafts.

Location

Alberta

Meetings take place via teleconference or face-to-face in CPA Alberta's Edmonton or Calgary offices.

Time Commitment

Varies dependent on the volume of exposure drafts issued.

Approximately 15 hours per exposure draft (five to 10 hours of preparation, as well as three to five hours meeting time).

Requirements

Must be a CPA Alberta member in good standing.

Have senior level professional experience and expertise.
